Talk about:

Sometimes it is hard to love others. With God’s help anything is possible. Wear a headband to declare how you are strong like Elsa, positive like Anna, unselfish like Sven the reindeer or caring like the stone trolls.

Paper strips for bands around head. Sticky tabs, card, large ear shape templates, antler templates, colouring mediums, collage materials, sticky gems etc

Need white/black balloons, black and orange funky foam, glue, cotton wool balls.</p>
<p>Frozen snow globes</p> 	<p>Storms in our lives – Jesus calms the storm Matthew 8:23-27</p> <p>Talk about: Trust in Jesus. When things get tough we need to ask Jesus to be with us. Jesus is our protector. Who protected Anna? When have you had stormy times in your life?</p>	<p>Cheap water bottles, confetti, food colouring, Frozen wrapping paper to cut out characters, glycerin http://adventuresinallthingsfood.blogspot.co.uk/2014/01/a-day-for-play-frozen-fun-and-diy-snow.html</p>
<p>Ice castle</p> 	<p>1 John 4:18 Love can thaw a frozen heart</p> <p>Talk about: Our hearts aren't frozen, but what is in our hearts can be changed by Jesus' love. Elsa saves her sister from a frozen heart. What is real love?</p>	<p>Invite Messy congregation and team to bring large ice blocks to the session (fill ice cream containers with water and place in home freezers). Use filled balloons frozen. Place ice bricks onto a builders tray. Pour salt over ice and watch the thaw. Use brushes/pipettes to drop food colouring into crevasses. Science experiment</p>
<p>Love Box</p> 	<p>'Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.' 1 John 4:8</p> <p>Real love is the love that Jesus has for each one of us. Create a box, place your name inside and know that Jesus would never empty you from his heart.</p>	<p>Card, small box templates, crayons, ribbon, sequin decorations. <p>Troll potato</p> 	<p>'God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.' Psalm 46:1</p> <p>Talk about: The stone trolls had a deeper knowledge of Elsa's magic. Elsa's parents took Anna to see the trolls when they needed help. Who do you trust during times of trouble? Who is always there for you?</p>	<p>You need a variety of vegetables, potatoes, halved cocktail sticks, chopping board, knives.</p> <p>Create features for the potatoes by chopping vegetables and use halved cocktail sticks to secure to the potato.</p>
<p>Sock Olaf</p> 	<p>God created us and knows us intimately. Psalm 139</p> <p>Olaf is such a happy character.</p> <p>'There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment.' 1 John 4:18</p> <p>Some people are worth melting for.</p>	<p>Stuff a white sock with supermarket value rice or use the inside of a supermarket value pillow! Use elastic bands/wool to make the body sections. Use felt/fun foam and permanent markers to decorate. Wind a chenille stick around body for arms. Large googly eyes look good! <p>Sven cakes</p> 	<p>'So in everything, do to others what you would have the m do to you...' Matthew 7:12</p> <p>Talk about: Sven the reindeer is kind, helpful and unselfish. Talk about any acts of kindness you have received.</p>	<p>Value supermarket fairy sponge cakes; chocolate flavoured butter icing; round amoretto biscuits; small chocolate buttons; sugar candy eyes; chopped Cadbury Curlywurly bars for antlers</p> <p>Remember this is a Sven cake not a Rudolph Christmas cake, so NO red nose!</p>
<p>Sparkly snowflakes</p> 	<p>'Now you are the body of Christ and each one of you is a part of it.' 1 Corinthians 12:27</p> <p>Talk about: Individual snowflakes are uniquely made, but when they stick together they make a big impact. Each one of us, in our own uniqueness, could work together to accomplish the work of the church. Elsa had icy magic powers but did it make for happiness? Before we start I need to tell you that however you are feeling today – Jesus knows, Jesus cares and Jesus hasn't forgotten you, because Jesus loves you.

Now what can I tell you about frozen that you don't already know?

We have Elsa, with magical powers, to make everything freeze – but she was frightened: frightened to touch anything, she was locked up, frightened to play with her sister Anna, frightened she would hurt Anna. I wonder what that felt like?

I wonder if you are frightened of anything, like Elsa?

Then there was Anna. She was playful, she wanted to have fun, she was full of adventure, but she was lonely – she had no friends to play with.

I wonder if you have ever felt lonely?

Of course Anna met Hans and wanted to get married but when they told Elsa, Elsa was angry. She lost control and turned the ground to ice – everyone looked at Elsa: is she bewitched? Is she crazy?

Elsa was frightened so she ran and ran turning everything she touched into ice.

Elsa couldn't hold back, she was frightened. She finally had freedom to lose control. I wonder if you have ever felt like Elsa, wanting to lose control and shout and scream and run fast.

Jesus said: Come to me – run to me and I will give you rest. Jesus said: Give me all your worries because I care for you.

Have you got worries, are you frightened like Elsa or lonely like Anna? – Jesus wants to know.

Write or draw any of your fears on a piece of paper. When everyone is ready, crumple the paper into a ball and, after 1 2 3 countdown, all throw snowball prayers to this target/catcher.

Jesus also said this: Be strong – love your enemies, don't be unkind or mean, love, be gentle, care for others, because with Jesus you are not frozen but unfrozen! Amen.
